



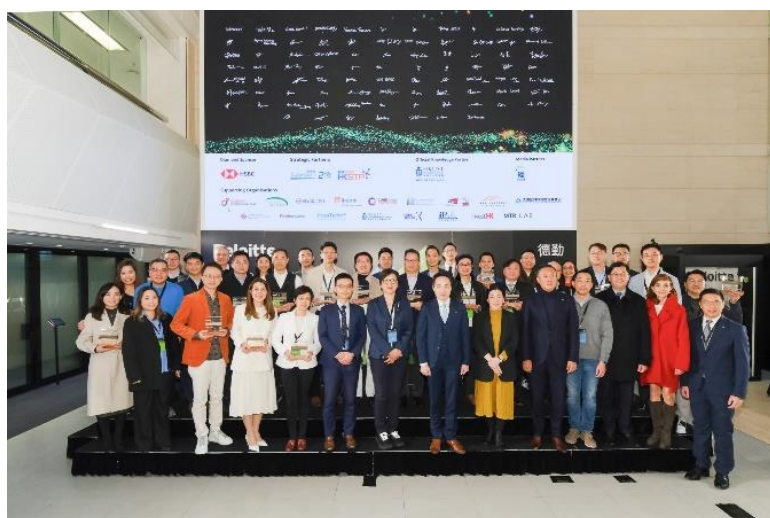

**HKSTP Celebrates the Remarkable Achievements of 25 Park Companies with a Record Number of Awards at the 2023 Deloitte Hong Kong Technology Fast & Rising Star Ceremony**

**(Hong Kong, 29 January 2024)** — Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP) extends its congratulations to its Partner companies and incubatees for their distinguished performance, which has been recognised with a collective total of 25 honours at the 2023 Deloitte Hong Kong Technology Fast & Rising Star awards. Notably, 10 Park companies have made it into the Hong Kong Technology Fast (HKTF) ranking, which recognises the fastest-growing and most innovative enterprises in Hong Kong; while 15 Park companies have been acknowledged in the Hong Kong Rising Star (HKRS) ranking, signifying their position as young leading-edge companies with considerable potential for growth in their industry segments.

The Deloitte Technology Fast 50 program was founded in 1995 in Silicon Valley, USA, and is held annually in over 30 countries. It was first launched in China in 2005. The Deloitte Hong Kong Technology Fast & Rising Star is a sub-project of the Deloitte China Technology Fast program. Companies recognised in the Hong Kong Technology Fast (HKTF) ranking automatically become candidates for the Deloitte China Technology Fast 50, and winners of the Hong Kong Rising Star (HKRS) are likewise candidates for the Deloitte China Rising Star Program.
